Official Testing Date College Noisy le Roi	22 nd February 2019

How to Apply

We suggest that you start collecting the various documents to avoid a last-minute panic. Once you start an application, we can see it in our data base and so we are informed that you are applying. This will allow us to contact you with important information (or to remind you gently about deadlines...)

We do **NOT** accept paper documents or incomplete dossiers. All applications must go through Applications Online via our website <http://sectioninternationale.org/college-applications/>

APPLY NOW

Once you press APPLY NOW, you will be asked to create/log into an account:

- If this is the first time you are applying through Applications Online, you will need to enter a valid email and password. You will receive an email to validate the account. Once you have validated the account, you can start to fill in the details required in the Application Form.
- If you have already used Applications Online, you should use the same account and the option "Add a Child". Please note that you need to "Add a Child" even if you created the account for the child currently in CM2...It will be treated as a new application for a change of programme.
- You do not have to finish the application in one go, but we do urge you to use "SAVE" at the end of each page to avoid having to start again...
- Once you have filled in the personal details, you can start uploading your documents.

ALL documents must be uploaded in **PDF FORMAT**

Documents are assessed on merit, not the order of arrival, so we urge you to make sure that your child's dossier is complete before submitting, as you will be unable to change it or add documents later.

- **Letter of motivation in English from the parents.** This can be typed with Word (or equivalent), exported and uploaded. You are NOT required to print, sign, scan and upload. The letter should explain family dynamics, past schooling, etc. Please remember that the team of teachers at the College level do not know your child so any important information you wish to pass on should be included here.
- **School reports for the previous school year:** you will need to upload the reports for CM1 (or equivalent). Please compile **ONE PDF document** for the two or three reports you have for the school year 2017-2018.
- **School reports for the current school year:** depending on the school your child is currently attending, you may receive this as late as the end of January 2019. Please wait for this report before submitting, as we can only assess complete dossiers.
- **Handwritten piece of work:** Please follow your child's class work and homework closely in order to be able to submit a piece of work reflecting your child's level. This piece of work could be a book report, creative writing, a series of diary entries, etc. Please do not submit spelling or grammar exercises. We are looking to assess their level of vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, general presentation and punctuation. You may submit several pieces of work, but only **ONE PDF** document.
- **CNED documents:** this concerns children who are not currently attending a school which is officially recognised by the French ministry of Education and applies to children usually abroad.
- **Other documents you may find relevant:** this may concern previous exams or certificates. Also, previous years of school reports (English-speaking school if already moved back, or French school before moving abroad, ...)

English Teacher Recommendation for Section Internationale, La Celle St Cloud-Noisy le Roi

Please ask your child's current English Teacher to submit this recommendation form before the deadline, **ideally** by PDF/email. If this is your child's first year with the teacher, do not request this form too early, in order to allow the teacher to get to know your child and his/her level.

This document is to be sent **directly** by the teacher to the Admissions Office (admissions@sectioninternationale.org) and so does not delay the submission of your application.

In order to comply with current GDPR rules, we encourage you to request this document from your English teacher with the following text, putting the Admissions Office on copy of the email:

We, the parents of Harry Potter (the name of your child), hereby authorise Mr or Mrs XXXX (name of teacher) to fill in the College teacher recommendation with details concerning the academic record of our child Harry Potter (the name of your child).

We authorise Mr or Mrs XXXX (name of the teacher) to send this personal recommendation to the Admissions Office, Section Internationale, 30 Avenue de Circourt, 78170 La Celle St Cloud at the following email address "admissions@sectioninternationale.org".

We authorise the Admissions Office to share the details of this recommendation with the teachers of the College Section Internationale programmes, the Head of the school requested (College Pasteur or College de la Quintinye) as well as, if required, the Inspection Académique during the assessment of your child's dossier during the Commission Collège.



Application and Testing Fees

Once you submit your full application via Applications Online, you will be required to pay a **non-refundable** application fee of **105 Euros**. This is to be paid online using a credit card. These costs are **NOT** included in the annual school fees (if currently a pupil in Section Internationale).

Once your child's dossier has been assessed and if he/she is invited to test on **22nd February 2019**, you will be required to pay the **non-refundable testing fees of 35 Euros** (official testing date). This should be paid in advance by bank transfer to the following bank account under the reference "*Child's name Testing 2019*". A PDF screen shot of the bank transfer is to be sent to admissions@sectioninternationale.org.

Please note that if your child is unable to test at the official testing date on 22nd February 2019, he/she may be subject to an individual test which will be billed at **100 Euros**.

If you are not currently in France, your child may sit the test at a distance, with the help of his/her current school. Please refer to the distance testing procedure on our website for further details. Please note that these distance tests are billed at **100 Euros**.

Timing of the Application Process

Once your child has sat the test, the papers will be marked and assessed by the team of College teachers. During the Commission with the heads of the two colleges, which will take place during the month of March 2019, each dossier will be examined, taking into account:

- The French academic reports. Please note that the Section Internationale is an option for children who are coping well with the French curriculum.
- The English written and oral test results
- The English Teacher Recommendation

Results should be available by mid- April 2019 at the latest.

THE NEXT STEPS IF YOUR CHILD IS ADMISSIBLE TO SECTION INTERNATIONALE

College Pasteur

- If your child is currently attending Pasteur Primary School in the Integrated programme and you live in La Celle St Cloud, you will be required to fill in the AFFELNET* document which will be distributed by Pasteur Primary School. You should include the "*certificat e d'admissibilit *" issued ONCE your child's place is confirmed.
- If your child is currently attending Pasteur Primary School with a "*d rogation*", you will be required to fill in AFFELNET* and request a "*d rogation*" to attend College Pasteur. You will receive details of how to do this from Pasteur Primary School. You are required to fill in the 2nd page of the AFFELNET document and add the necessary supporting document (*certificat e d'admissibilit *) which will be issued by the Section Internationale ONCE your child's place is confirmed.
- If your child is currently in the Primary Wednesday programme and does not live in La Celle St Cloud, you will be required to fill in AFFELNET* and request a "*d rogation*". Your local primary school will inform you of how to request the "*d rogation*". You are required to fill in the 2nd page of the AFFELNET* document and add the necessary supporting document (*certificat e d'admissibilit *) which will be issued by the Section Internationale ONCE your child's place is confirmed.
- If you do not currently live in the area (but live in France), you will be required to fill in AFFELNET* and request a "*d rogation*". Your local primary school will inform you of how to request the "*d rogation*". You are required to fill in the 2nd page of the AFFELNET* document and add the necessary supporting document (*certificat e d'admissibilit *) which will be issued by the Section Internationale ONCE your child's place is confirmed.
- If you do not currently live in France, you are not required to fill in AFFELNET or request a "*d rogation*". We request that you contact us once you have found your new French address. If you are returning to a previous address, please refer to the different cases above.

College de la Quintinye

- If you live in Noisy le Roi or Bailly, the College de la Quintinye is your "*College de Secteur*". You will be required to fill in the AFFELNET* document which will be distributed by the local primary school. You should include the "*certificat e d'admissibilit *" issued ONCE your child's place is confirmed.
- If your child is currently in the Primary Wednesday programme and does not live in Noisy le Roi or Bailly, you will be required to fill in AFFELNET* and request a "*d rogation*" to attend College de la Quintinye. Your local primary school will inform you of how to request the "*d rogation*". You are required to fill in the 2nd page of the AFFELNET* document and add the necessary supporting document (*certificat e d'admissibilit *) which will be issued by the Section Internationale ONCE your child's place is confirmed.
- If you do not currently live in the area (but live in France), you will be required to fill in AFFELNET* and request a "*d rogation*". Your local primary school will inform you of how to request the "*d rogation*". You are required to fill in the 2nd page of the AFFELNET* document and add the necessary supporting document (*certificat e d'admissibilit *) which will be issued by the Section Internationale ONCE your child's place is confirmed.
- If you do not currently live in France, you are not required to fill in AFFELNET or request a "*d rogation*". We request that you contact us once you have found your new French address. If you are returning to a previous address, please refer to the different cases above.

*AFFELNET – *Affectation des Élèves par le NET* – for more information, please visit the official website for the *Académie de Versailles*. This should be updated for 2019, but the information is still accurate.

Écoles Privées hors Contrat (France)

If your child is currently attending a school “*privée hors contrat*” in France, he/she will have to sit the tests of the *Académie de Versailles* before being able to confirm the place in one of the two colleges. Examples are Montessori schools.

You should contact your local college (*collège de secteur*) in order to sit the tests required after having registered your child before the deadline. Once you receive the official confirmation from the *Académie de Versailles*, you should send a scanned copy to the Admissions Office admissions@sectioninternationale.org. Please visit the official websites for the ***Académie de Versailles*** or further details. These websites will be updated with the dates in 2019 but they do not vary much from year to year.

We also recommend that you contact the head of your child’s current school as they are well aware of the procedure to follow to enter the French public school system as well as the deadlines.

Écoles Privées hors Contrat (outside France)

If your child is currently attending a school “*privée hors contrat*” outside France, he/she will have to sit French and Maths tests of the *Académie de Versailles* before being able to confirm the place in one of the two colleges. This would be the case if your child attends a school which is not recognised by the French Ministry of Education (AEFE) and is not following a parallel official CNED (or equivalent) programme. These tests can be organised by Section Internationale, AFTER your child is confirmed admissible for the Section Internationale programme (in English). Please consult the distance testing procedure on our website for more information.

There is a 10% discount for a second child and any subsequent child(ren) from the same family enrolled in the *Section Internationale*. The discount is applied to the younger child(ren). For example, the fees for a family with one child in Collège Pasteur and one child in the Primary Wednesday programme would be:

The total annual fees will be paid by 10 monthly automatic withdrawals. The first withdrawal will be made on 10th October 2018 to reflect any increase determined at the September 2018 AGM. The nine remaining withdrawals will be made by 5th of each month from November 2018 through to July 2019.

All additional costs (book fees, membership fees and examination fees) will be debited on 10th October 2018, along with the first monthly payment.

A book fee per child is added to the general fees to cover the cost of buying the same edition for all fiction works, textbooks, atlases, etc. Parents will be held responsible for and will agree to cover the cost of textbooks lost by their children.
